| A | answers to questions: <br> vocabulary correct; answer expanded, proof of knowledge of subject; length of answer | $\square 5$ = very good: full, well-informed answers $\square 4=$ good: but one answer at fault, or hesitant reaction $\square 3=$ satisfactory; answer somewhat evasive/off the point $\square 2=$ below average: very brief <br> $\square 1=$ poor: one-word answers <br> $\square 0=$ unable to answer |
