Gabriella Cilmi is an 18-year-old Australian-Italian singer-songwriter. Her first successful song was the worldwide mega hit "Sweet about me", which sold over two million copies, was in the top 10 in 16 countries, and was viewed over 20 million times on YouTube; it spent 37 weeks in the UK singles chart in 2008 and was recently announced the most-played record of 2009. Her first album "Lessons to be Learned" went top 10 in over 10 countries.

When she was 13 years old, she signed her first record contract and she won 6 area awards in her native Australia (e.g. Best Female, Best Album and Single of the Year). Gabriella was nominated for a Brit Award, MTV Europe Award and Echo Award.

At the beginning of her career, she was marked out for her beauty and powerful voice. Her second album "Ten" was published in 2010. Gabriella has lived the life of a young, single woman in cities thousands of miles from her home and family.
